## **ENTRY RULES**

1. Entries will only be accepted from members of the British Cactus and Succulent Society. Entry will be free. There will be no prize monies.
2. Exhibitors will be allowed a maximum of **two entries** in each class.
3. Entries must reach the Show Secretary not later than **Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2025**
4. Plant classification and judging will be in accordance with the '**Handbook of Shows 11th. Edition 2021**'
5. All entries to be staged between 6.30 p.m. and 7.30 p.m. on the day of the show.
6. Judging will commence promptly at 7.30 p.m.
7. The judges may, at their discretion, withhold an award in any class where they consider that the standard of the exhibits is too low.
8. Any objections must be submitted in writing to the Show Secretary within one hour of the end of judging on the day of the show. The judges reviewed decision is final.
9. Class points will be awarded as follows: First place; 5 points - Second place; 3 points - Third place; 2 points - Highly Commended (H.C.); 1 point.
10. All exhibits will be staged at the owner's risk. The Cambridge Branch or its Show Committee cannot accept any responsibility for the safety of the exhibits or any personal property. All reasonable precautions will be taken against theft or damage.
11. All cups and trophies remain the property of Cambridge Branch at all times.
12. Entry in the show constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
